Investing back into our communities is more than a job. It's a way of life. It's part of who we are. It is what we are meant to do.

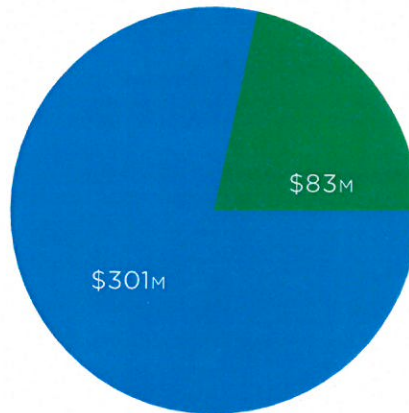

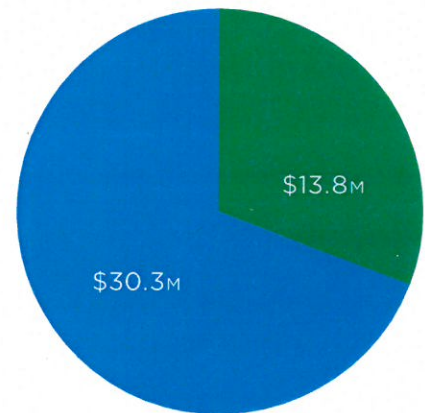


\$301M Benefits to the poor and under-served: Includes traditional charity care, community health services, and the cost of unreimbursed care for those who qualify for Medicaid
