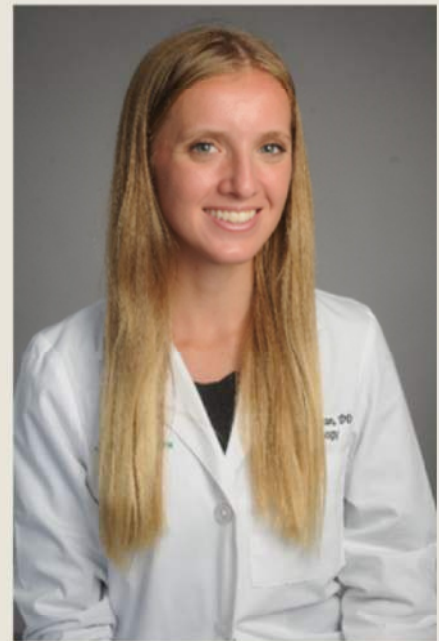
About Me & my Hobbies
